Budgeting Categories for Missions Resource Distribution

For most churches missions is broad but not all ministry opportunities are equally strategic. It is helpful to categorize the ministries supported or being considered in order to analyze where your church is deploying its resources, set priorities for the future, establish percentage goals, and make financial decisions.
